




Scope

Each work area consists of a number of Co-Lead Partnerships

Aim



- Promote common understanding of water challenges in China and Europe
- Identify specific water challenges faced in both China and Europe where Co-Lead Partnerships within each Work Area can stimulate innovation in research, policy and technology
- Reach firm agreements on next steps, including activities to be carried out during 2014-2015





- For each Co-Lead Partnership: Work Package 2014-2015
- Solid input to forthcoming:
 - CEWP Work Plan 2014
 - CEWP Work Programme 2014-2017
- Solid input to Horizon 2020 application

Work Package 2014-2015, Key questions and hence content



- Each Work Package shall answer a few key questions
 - Which activities will be carried out (meetings, seminars, surveys, analyses, exhibitions, etc.)? The more precise answers, the better
 - When will they be carried out?
 - Who will be responsible for each activity, both in China and Europe?
 - Has financing been secured?
 - What is the target audience, both in China and Europe?
 - What are the expected outcomes and outputs?





- Work Packages 2014-2015 to be presented by the Co-Lead Partners at the 4th Steering Committee meeting scheduled for May-June 2014
- Co-Lead Partnerships may develop over time
 - some may merge into one
 - some may cease to exist
- Inception Workshop and Work Packages 2014-2015 constitute a first step and only a first step
